Requirements for designation as an officiant competent to solemnize a civil marriage or a civil union

The person must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent residence in Québec;
- Be of full age and capable of exercising all of his or her civil rights;
- Not have been convicted of a crime in the last three years;
- Not have been convicted of an offence prosecuted summarily in the past year;
- Speak English or French;
- Meet all formal and substantive requirements regarding civil marriages and civil unions.
