The party who summons you must advance to you, for the first day of attendance, the loss of time indemnity and the travel, meal and overnight accommodation allowances. The amount of those allowances is set by government regulation. Keep your receipts in order to receive the amounts to which you are entitled.

After your examination, present your summons and your receipts to the financial service counter of the courthouse or to any other place indicated to you, in order to receive the amounts to which you are entitled under the regulations in force.

Compensation must be paid by the party that summoned you.
