

EXPLANATORY NOTES

CONTESTATION OF RIGHT TO CONTINUE SUIT (SJ-852-02A)

The “Contestation of Right to Continue Suit” form allows a party to a small claims application to contest a notice of continuance of suit by indicating his or her reasons. If the notice is not contested within 10 days of receipt, the continuance of suit is deemed to be allowed.

TYPE OF FORM

- Dynamic PDF:

After completing the form, you can print it on letter-sized paper, i.e. 8.5 inches by 11 inches (215.9 mm by 279.4 mm).

- Paper:

If you complete the form by hand, please write legibly in block letters.

Once the form is completed, you should keep a copy for your files.

FILING AT THE COURT OFFICE

You must then submit the contestation to the Small Claims Division office at the courthouse where the application was filed. To do this, you may use the Digital Court Office of Québec (GNJQ), which is accessible via the website of the Ministère de la Justice at www.justice.gouv.qc.ca.

The clerk will then send the contestation to the other parties to notify them, and submit the contestation to the court so a decision can be rendered.
