

EXPLANATORY NOTES

CONTESTATION OF RIGHT TO CONTINUE SUIT (SJ-852-02A)

The “Contestation of Right to Continue Suit” form allows a party to a small claims application to contest a notice of continuance of suit by indicating his or her reasons. If the notice is not contested within 10 days of receipt, the continuance of suit is deemed to be allowed.

TYPE OF FORM

This form is available in dynamic PDF format, meaning the form can be downloaded from www.justice.gouv.qc.ca and completed directly on screen.

- Dynamic PDF:

After completing the form, you must print it on letter-sized paper, i.e. 8.5 inches by 11 inches (215.9 mm by 279.4 mm). Be sure to set your printer to this paper size.

- Paper:

If you complete the form by hand, please write legibly in block letters.

PROCEDURE

Once the form is completed, you should keep a copy for your files. You must then submit the duly signed original to the clerk at the courthouse where the small claims application was filed. The clerk will then send the “Contestation of right to continue suit” form to the other parties to notify them, and submit the contestation to the court so a decision can be rendered.
